

Criteria for admission as a Professional Member of the ATII

1) A primary degree or postgraduate qualification in translation and/or interpreting awarded by an Irish third-level institution or similar foreign institution recognised by the Association of Translators and Interpreters Ireland

Plus

A minimum of 3 years documented, full-time work as a translator and/or interpreter (or a correspondingly longer period part-time), wherein a year's work is considered to be a minimum of (a) 200,000 words, (b) 40 days or 280 hours interpreting, or (c) an equivalent combination of (a) and (b)

Plus

A PASS in the ATII Professional Membership Examination

OR

2) A minimum of 3 years associate membership of the ATII

Plus

A minimum of 3 years documented, full-time work as a translator and/or interpreter (or a correspondingly longer period part-time) since becoming an Associate Member, wherein a year's work is considered to be a minimum of (a) 200,000 words, (b) 40 days or 280 hours interpreting, or (c) an equivalent combination of (a) and (b)

Plus

A PASS in the ATII Professional Membership Examination
